Dear John,

I write to outline the outstanding achievements students have made at our College using the Lexia developed learning materials.

Achievements that students have made in literacy and numeracy have been quite outstanding, especially for students who have not had great success with any other program or support that has been in place for them.

Students, especially those in the senior years have gained confidence, skills and shown enthusiasm for their learning for the first time. Indeed, if you visit the classroom when they are working, they will ignore distractions and remain focussed on their work.

The Lexia program is self paced and allows individual students to progress at their own rate. Many students have been able to show many months of growth in very short periods of time, and this growth is then translated into subjects where teachers have noted a considerable improvement in understanding and application.

Staff, who support the Lexia program, have become experts in its use within a very short period of time and are committed to the program due to its demonstrable outcomes for students.

For staff one of the most important aspects of Lexia is within the reporting system. The Lexia reporting systems works in a number of different ways, these are;

1. It allows staff to follow a students progress and target teach on an identified specific area of difficulty shown by a student. This is efficient use of staff time and allows continued rapid improvement by the student.
2. The reporting system identifies and recommends areas that a teacher should be working on in a group or class situation.
3. Data collection provided by the reporting systems clearly allows the school to look at its curriculum and identify areas that need addressing to meet the needs of all students.

Of course there are many areas within cognitive function/dysfunction that Lexia addresses inclusive of extending higher order thinking skills.

We have recommended Lexia too many other schools and they have taken on the program after seeing first hand the successes our students have achieved.
